Escape to Another World in San José Dollar Days at Kelley Park

San José, CA – May 29, 2007

Escape to another world right in San José as History San José and Happy Hollow Park & Zoo partner to offer low-cost access to two of San Jose's most significant attractions---all inside Kelley Park.

On Tuesday, June 12, July 10 and August 14, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., admission to Happy Hollow Park & Zoo is only \$1.00 per person. * This summertime outing offers families a chance to combine animals, history and gardens, all in one place: Kelley Park in San José. The 'Escape to Another World' can continue from Happy Hollow Park & Zoo, through the Japanese Friendship Garden, into History Park, all in one day.

"Kelley Park is an incredible place for families and has so much to offer," said Vanessa Rogier, Marketing Director of Happy Hollow Park & Zoo. "Everyone loves animals! Then add the serenity of the Japanese Friendship Garden and the fascination of History Park---all right here in San José's backyard."

On Tuesday, July 10 only, donations of canned goods, benefiting Second Harvest Food Bank, will allow free admission to Happy Hollow Park & Zoo and History Park.

At Happy Hollow, the newest and "miniest" member of the Happy Hollow horse herd was born on April 13 and stands just 19" tall. See a lemur, a jaguar and a parma wallaby. Families can enjoy the puppet shows, rides – including Danny the Dragon, play areas, and over 150 animals in the Zoo.

The Japanese Friendship Garden provides a serene resting place. As a replica of a garden in Okayama, Japan, see the koi pond, waterfalls, ducks and more.

At History Park, visit the Trolley Barn and ride a trolley through the park, visit the Print Shop. Enjoy educational docent-led tours of historical buildings and go inside the 1871 one-room School House. O'Brien's Café serves ice cream and has a new lunch menu. The Gift Shop will be open all day.

“History San José is thrilled to partner with Happy Hollow to introduce the pleasures of Kelley Park,” said Marilyn Guida, Director of Education at History San José. “The potential to learn new things about our Valley is endless, and it is all here for all ages.”

Inside the Pacific Hotel is the exhibit *Speed City: from Civil Rights to Black Power*.

Located at 1300 Senter Road, in Kelley Park, San José, this 6-acre garden was patterned after Korakuen in Okayama, San Jose's sister city. Its open park-like plan is different from the stereotypical Japanese garden, but this one still includes familiar elements such as koi ponds, streams, waterfall, and a teahouse.
