Come for a class and stay and play all day. Admission and parking is free for class participants on the day of their class!



Stroller Safari (Ages 10 months-2 years with an adult)

This class is for adults with infants and/or toddlers who want to learn more about the zoo and its residents! Enjoy a stroll through Happy Hollow to view different animals each week and meet an animal up close. Learn how we make animal exhibits engaging for young children and stay after class for informal play time to get to know other zoo families. This class meets for three sessions. Please respect age restrictions and do not bring older siblings to class. Class fee is for 1 child and 1 adult. Each additional participant requires an additional fee.

Playtime at the Zoo

People aren't the only ones who play...many animals practice their survival skills and make friends by playing games—while having lots of fun, too! Meet some playful pals, and help your child learn through play in our themed play areas.

Tales for Tots (Ages 2-3 with an adult)

Stories come to life in this exciting three-part class. Toddlers and their adults will hear a story and explore the world of the story through songs, hands-on activities, and by meeting live animals. Please respect age restrictions and do not bring younger/older siblings to class. Class fee is for 1 child and 1 adult. Each additional participant is an additional fee.

Habitat Explorers

Exploring habitats through stories and live animal encounters will introduce little ones to the importance of animals finding the right home.

Animal ABCs

Span the alphabet while we learn about animals from A to Z! We'll practice our ABCs while learning about zoo animals along the way.

Zoo Kids (Ages 3-4 and 4-5)

A wonderful way for your child to explore the world of animals in a safe, friendly environment. Each class includes interactive lessons on the topic, hands-on activities, crafts, and meeting animals. Zoo Kid classes are designed as a three-part series. Children must be potty trained and comfortable attending class unaccompanied.

Romp and Stomp!

Romp, stomp, crawl, slither, trot, or jump into the fun as we learn about the many ways animals move! Find out who are the fastest and slowest animals and join us as we "move it, move it" the animal way.

Wild Science (Ages 6-7 and 8-9)

Explore the wild world of biology in this hands-on class, geared to meet CA Science Standards. Each "edutaining" class includes an interactive discussion, inquiry-based activities, and a visit from one of our animals. Join us for a class full of discovery and awe—great for homeschoolers too!

Riveting Rainforests

Dive into the depths of a tropical rainforest! Explore the unique characteristics of each layer of the rainforest and how the diverse plants and animals that live there work as a team.

Jr. Keepers (Ages 7-9 and 10-13)

Does raking, scooping, feeding, enriching, and caring for exotic animals sound interesting to you? Then join the zoo crew! Learn a variety of zoo keeping skills and help Happy Hollow's zookeepers take care of our zoo animals. Jr. Keepers will explore different aspects of zoo keeping throughout the year.

Animal Training

Do zoo animals do tricks? No, but sometimes they are trained to execute natural behaviors. Find out how Zoo Keepers train the animals, what behaviors they train them to do, and why!

Family Fun (Ages 2+ with an adult)

These fun family classes are filled with activities for adults and children to do together. Each class includes an interactive discussion, hands-on activities, games and crafts, and meeting live animals. This class is geared for ages 5 and up; however younger siblings ages 2-4 may participate if preregistered. Class fee is for 1 child and 1 adult. Each additional participant is an additional fee.

Zoo Babies

Bring your joeys, chicks and kids to the zoo! (Human kids, that is – we have plenty of goats already!) Animals are born and grow up in lots of different ways. Meet new friends and find out more about bringing up baby - the wild way!

Bird Watching at the Hollow

Happy Hollow is pleased to partner with the Don Edwards San Francisco Bay National Wildlife Refuge on this exciting family program. A Don Edwards SF Bay NWR Interpretive Specialist will present an interactive discussion on local bird habitats and adaptations, provide you with the basics on how to conduct a successful bird-watching session, and guide you on a bird-watching tour through Happy Hollow.

Ski Week Camp at the Hollow! (Ages 5-9)

Spend your week off school learning at the zoo. Our camps are filled with hands-on educational activities, meeting live animals up-close, zoo tours and more. Camps are limited to 24 participants and children attend camps independently (without parents/guardians).

Home Sweet Habitat

From deserts to swamps, Happy Hollow has heaps of habitats—and the habitats are homes to our animals! Discover what makes a hole a home, and how zoos create comfortable exhibits for each of our different species.

Ski Week After Camp Care (Ages 5-9)

Chill out for a few more hours after camp with movies, rides and games.

Happy Hollow for Grown Ups (Ages 18+)

Zoo class isn't just for kids! Find a sitter and join in our adult classes to visit the Hollow after hours. Participate in live animal presentations, zoo-themed activities for adults, and have a great time at the zoo after hours.

Woo at the Zoo

Explore the wild world of animal dating and mating when the sun goes down! Join us on Valentine's Day for this light-hearted class. Enjoy some hors d'oeuvres and meet animals with bizarre reproductive habits.

California Natives

California is home to nearly 37 million people—but it's also home to a diverse range of animals. Become more familiar with the animals that share your backyard, and learn some tips on how to cohabitate peacefully.

Photography Workshop: You at the Zoo! (Ages 18+)

Have you ever wondered how photographers capture amazing images of zoo animals without obstruction from fences or glass glare? Have you ever wanted to learn more about the animals in those photos? Come to Happy Hollow's Photography Workshop: You and the Zoo! Learn more about how to use your camera to take high-impact animal portraits, post-process your photos, and help spread conservation messages by sharing your works of art!
